At the Raptor Free Flight, watch as the amazing aerialists soar and swoop in their native desert habitat while a narrator describes their attributes, habitats and behaviors including Chihuahuan Raven, Great Horned Owl, Prairie Falcon, Ferruginous Hawk, Red-tailed Hawk, Gray Hawk, Barn Owl, Peregrine Falcon and Harris's Hawks.



